Council Meeting Highlights – February 24, 2026

The Town of Blackfalds Council held its Regular Council Meeting on Monday, February 24, 2026. Below are the key decisions and discussions from the meeting.

CONSENT AGENDA

Council adopted the Consent Agenda for February 24, 2026, which included minutes from recent Council and Standing Committee meetings, Council and Administrative reports, board and committee minutes, regional council highlights, and correspondence from the RCMP and partner agencies.

DELEGATIONS

Toddler Park Proposal – Optimist Club

Council received a presentation from Edie Harris, representing the Optimist Club of Blackfalds regarding a proposed toddler playground.

BUSINESS ITEMS

Optimist Club Playground Project

Council approved providing a letter of support for the Club's Kal's RePlay Fund application, identifying Prairie Ridge Park as the proposed location pending community engagement.

Taxi Business Bylaw Amendment – Bylaw 1349.26

Council gave First, Second, and Third Reading to the Taxi Business Bylaw Amendment, which updates the required driver's abstract period from ten years to three.

Natural Gas Franchise Fee Bylaw – Bylaw 1350.26

Note: Councillor Sands recused himself due to a conflict of interest.

Council supported continuing the franchise relationship with ATCO Gas and gave First Reading to the Bylaw.

Council directed Administration to register Mayor Svab and Councillor Twerdoclib for the March 30 session, and two members of Administration for the March 24 session.
